Route 1

Take Hwy. 401, Hwy. 409 or Hwy. 407 to Hwy. 427 North. Continue North on Hwy. 427 to Hwy. 7. Go West (left) on Hwy. 7 to Hwy. 50. Go North (right) on Hwy. 50 to Bolton. Go through town of Bolton. Course is located 5 km north of Bolton on the East (right) side.

Route 2

Take Hwy. 400 to King Road exit. Go West on King Rd. to Queen St. (also known as Hwy. 50). Go North (right) on Hwy. 50. Course is located 5 km north of Bolton on the East (right) side.

Glen Eagle is a soft spike facility. Collared shirts, casual slacks, shorts no more than 4" above the knee are required. Jeans and/or cut-offs are not permitted.
